

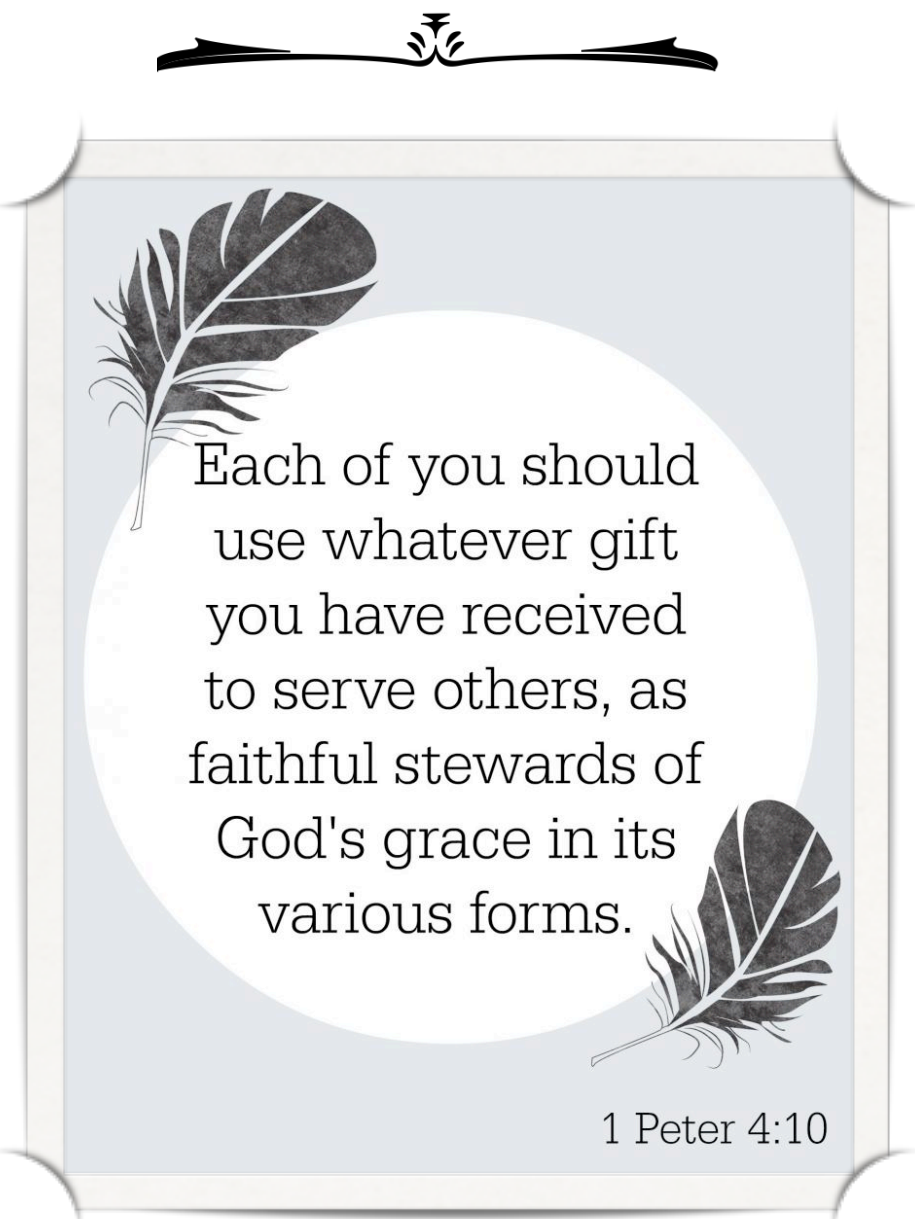
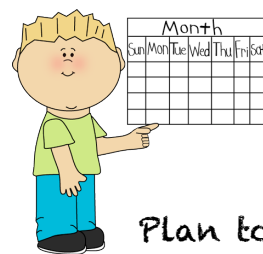

The Grace of God



Our God is graceful. It's just part of who He is.

God's grace is powerful! It holds the power to
provide restoration to our soul and spirit. His
grace is able to make us strong even in times of
weakness. His grace also holds power to help
us experience a consistent walk with our Father
in heaven.

1Pe 5:10-11 *And the God of all grace, who
called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you
have suffered a little while, will himself restore
you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.
(11) To him be the power for ever and ever.
Amen.*

The very gospel (good news) that we, as
Christians responded to and now strive to share
with others is referred to by Paul as "The gospel
of His grace."

Act 20:24 *However, I consider my life worth
nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race
and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given
me—the task of testifying to the good news of
God's grace.*

The abundance riches of His grace have been
revealed "In Christ"

Eph. 2:4-9 *But because of his great love for us,
God, who is rich in mercy, (5) made us alive
with Christ even when we were dead in
transgressions—it is by grace you have been
saved. (6) And God raised us up with Christ
and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in
Christ Jesus, (7) in order that in the coming
ages he might show the incomparable riches of
his grace, expressed in his kindness to us in
Christ Jesus. (8) For it is by grace you have
been saved, through faith—and this is not from
yourselves, it is the gift of God— (9) not by
works, so that no one can boast.*

Paul describes the Grace of God as nothing
short of GLORIOUS! Grace is a FREE gift from
God given to us in Christ. There is NOTHING

we could ever do to "earn" this grace or to
"repay" God for His grace that is given freely.

Eph. 1:3-6 *Praise be to the God and Father of
our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the
heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in
Christ. (4) For he chose us in him before the
creation of the world to be holy and blameless
in his sight. In love (5) he predestined us for
adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in
accordance with his pleasure and will— (6) to
the praise of his glorious grace, which he has
freely given us in the One he loves.*

God extends His grace to all and His heart's
desire is for ALL to experience His grace. IF we
are willing to learn God's grace, it is able to
teach us how to live "graceful" lives – lives full
of grace. Certainly there is no better way to
live! Living a life that brings glory to God is a
blessing to others that we come in contact with.

Tit. 2:11-14 *For the grace of God has appeared
that offers salvation to all people. (12) It
teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and
worldly passions, and to live self-controlled,
upright and godly lives in this present age, (13)
while we wait for the blessed hope—the
appearing of the glory of our great God and
Savior, Jesus Christ, (14) who gave himself for
us to redeem us from all wickedness and to
purify for himself a people that are his very own,
eager to do what is good.*
