#### WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

## ONE MORE TIME

"Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me."
Psalm 23:4

It was a Friday evening in Richmond, Virginia. She ("Mom") had lost all hope. She thought she was alone with no one to help her. She thought God hadn't listened to her cry for help. She thought she had failed God. But by Tuesday at noon, everything had changed for the better. She and her children were safe again. She was smiling again. She was rested and ready to face life's challenges again.

What happened?

Intervention. Mom's children called a friend who did what he could; his family helped them leave a dangerous situation.

Advocates. Mom's friend didn't know what to do; but he knew who to call. He called another friend who had had her own troubles but was doing better. Her advice, contacts and advocacy were all invaluable. A plan was made to go to the Homeless Point of Entry in Richmond on Monday.

Faith; Prayer; God's Grace and Power. Things didn't look promising upon everyone's arrival at the Homeless Point of Entry that Monday morning. Many others were there, all with needs. However, after resting, praying and worshiping with the saints over the weekend, Mom knew what was needed: a particular shelter with a particular staff that she knew; a particular shelter that would help her family and, above all, be safe. And, though Mom's friend agreed about the need, he wasn't so sure it would work out so specifically. Neither was the Social Worker, who nonetheless agreed to make the

call. Everyone left the room so the Social Worker could do his work.

Mom and her daughter didn't wait in the lobby. They went outside while her friend waited. After a few minutes, everyone reunited with the Social Worker, who announced that they had a room. The biggest one; in the safe place; with the staff that could be trusted; who remembered Mom and had recently been wondering how Mom was doing! The room was prepared and the whole family stayed in it for several days, starting over and discovering opportunities to go to work.

What were they doing outside as they waited to hear from the Social Worker? Praying. Praying for a specific answer. An answer that God provided.

What's eating you? Are you praying about it? Do you pray with specificity? Do you pray faithfully? Do you pray continually?

My friend has her struggles and has struggled for a long time. Right now, she's not doing so well. Makes me sad.

But I'll never forget how she, after losing hope and home, was able to summon up the courage to pray One More Time.
